Certificates will be awarded for mileages starting at 1,000 and 2,000 miles and thereafter in 5,000 mile increments. We also plan to award prizes at year end. Mileage Recognition Awards are beneficial to club members in several different ways. Mileage Recognition Awards could substantially increase the value of your vehicle at the time of sale, and the mileage recognition certificate shows that your car, with a written mileage record, is a capable travel vehicle.

Basically we're looking at a standard Model A with either an A or B block with standard frame and suspension, built between late 1927 and 1931. The vehicle must be licensed in your jurisdiction.

Alternators, radial tires, accessory wheels, hydraulic brakes, turn signals, seat belts, additional mirrors and taillights, safety items, overdrives and 12 volt systems, air conditioning, trailer hitches, and radios are acceptable accessories.
